## Alfama

## Sintra

It is a major tourist destination in Portugal, thanks to its picturesqueness and for its historic palaces and castles.

The city was the most important center of Portugal's fishing industry. In the beginning of the 20th century, particularly specializing in processing and exporting sardines.
